PARADE RULES

ARTICLE ONE: Santa hats only, absolutely **NO** Santas. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

...you will not be allowed to participate in parade.

ARTICLE TWO: For the safety of everyone; **NO VECHICLE** in the parade shall

allow the **THROWING** of candy, leaflets, handouts, premiums or any giveaways into the crowd. Walkers accompanying the

float may **HAND OUT** candy, etc.

ARTICLE THREE: All participants shall start the parade in their **ASSIGNED**

NUMBERED SPOT. You cannot wait for the parade to come

to you and to enter.

ARTICLE FOUR: All participants will show their numbers to the designated

judges and broadcast commentary officials.

ARTICLE FIVE: Holiday themed attire is strongly recommended for all

participants walking beside floats (limit of 8 per group). Points may be added by judges for enthusiastic participation.

ARTICLE SIX: NO baby carriages, strollers or animals (leashed or otherwise)

with participants in parade.

ARTICLE SEVEN: NO open flames and NO sharp objects on floats.

ARTICLE EIGHT: All motor vehicles must carry a certified fire extinguisher.

ARTICLE NINE: NO political messages.

ARTICLE TEN: Participants shall remain on floats for the entire parade. Do

not unload vehicles or floats until you reach the end of the

parade route.
